One of the approaches that was considered important was to make ourselves noticed by politicians. As powerful as online petitions and emails campaigns are, we believe that there is also an important place for actual letters to Members of Parliament from individual citizens; politicians pay attention to such letters because of their substance. The Letter Writing Aids section of our web site provides suggestions for an effective letter to your MP and a few sample letters that we have used in the past. We recommend that you choose one that you like, tailor it to reflect your own thinking, address it properly to your own member of parliament, and send it to him or her. We can attest to the positive impact that the delivery of a handful of postcards from The Postcard Underground had on us.

We have designated June as our letter writing month, and we will prepare more sample letters so that we can all contribute to the impact of many voices speaking in a similar way on the same topic.

Another concrete action we will take in June is to Black Out our website on Monday, June 4 in solidarity with the <u>BlackOutSpeakOut</u> campaign that is providing many ways to protest the Canadian government's Bill C-38 that has many provisions destructive to the environment as well as being of a form that erodes the principles of democracy. addresses the same issue.

On Climate Impact Day, May 5, a group of British Columbia citizens organized a symbolic blockade of a rail shipment of coal to BC ports.



1. Glaciers melt, there's more water in the ocean, sea levels rise; 2. Water expands when it warms, sea levels rise.




Climate models predict that sea levels will rise 30 to 80 inches by 2010. That's 2.5 feet to 6.5 feet.
